## **Legal Compliance Audit**

As a requirement of both ISO 14001 and ISO 45001, companies have to carry out an audit of their compliance to applicable legislation.

SSS can help in 2 ways:

- Providing the INTACT computerised action management system which has a structured list of legislation,

#### **Data input**

The input form comprises a list of legislation with tick boxes for "Applicable" and "Yes" or "No" for compliance. Double-clicking the regulation will tell you more about it.

If a regulation is applicable, you tick the "Applicable" box and then define how you show that you are compliant. By clicking on the "Full comments" button, you open the form shown below which has a set of evidence that may be applicable.

You enter how you meet the requirements of the regulation in the "How met" section

Regulation	Is the company complying with the requirements of the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002 (COSHH)?
How met	CoSHH assessments have been done. The use of substances hazardous to health is very limited and comprises stencilling ink, floor paints, etc. There are no substances which require health surveillance. Fumes from hot processes are extracted by an LEV system which is checked annually. There is no evidence that such fumes are hazardous, but it is at least a nuisance issue.

#### **Annual updates**

The standards require you to periodically check that you remain compliant. You would normally do this annually. The audit scheduling system with INTACT sets up dates automatically and sends reminders.

The INTACT legal compliance system is structured so that when you enter the next year's date the legislation is copied with the "Applicable" boxes ticked or not ticked as at the last audit. The report continues from the last report and there is a button that enables you to state that nothing has changed.
